Travel Reminders:

Documents:

- For the Olins travelling from the US you are reminded that in order to return to the US after the reunion you must have one of the following: a valid US passport, US passport card, an enhanced Drivers license or a Nexus card. These forms of identification must not have expired. If you need to get a new or renewal passport, you should apply now. That way, you will be fully prepared for the border crossings.

Currency:

- Canadians currency is issued in Dollars and Cents and in that way is similar to US currency. Canadians use a \$1 coin (Loonie) and a \$2 coin (Toonie). At the present time the American Dollar and Canadian Dollar are basically equivalent in value. Your best method of payment for items purchased in Canada is your Credit Card. Stores in Canada will usually discount the American dollars (cash purchases) by approximately 5% over the official exchange rate.
